City of Toledo Receives \$3 Million From Clean Ohio Fund For Fiberglas Tower

Toledo, OH - Today was a great day for one of Toledo's great old buildings. The City of Toledo received a \$3 million Clean Ohio Revitalization Fund (C.O.R.F.) grant to conduct remediation work on the former Fiberglas Tower. Upon hearing this exciting news, Mayor Carty Finkbeiner released the following statement:

"We have been attempting to persuade a developer and the State of Ohio to assist in a major revitalization of the former world headquarters of Owens-Corning, commonly referred to as the Fiberglas Tower. Nick Eyde of Lansing, Michigan has worked diligently with the City of Toledo for the past year to produce a major rejuvenation of The Tower. For Mr. Eyde to move forward, he needed this \$3 million C.O.R.F. grant from the State of Ohio. Now that it has been approved, we anticipate that the revitalization plan will move forward with dispatch. We are very grateful to the State of Ohio and the Eyde Corporation, and look forward in seeing this building contributing to the ongoing renaissance of Downtown Toledo."
