



## Outside Toledo City Limits 2018 Water & Sewer Rates

The Department of Public Utilities (DPU) supplies high quality drinking water for the City of Toledo and many surrounding areas. Toledo draws raw water from Lake Erie, tests and treats it to meet or exceed all quality standards, then transports safe drinking water through its distribution system to communities outside the city.

Toledo charges bulk contract rates to communities based on Toledo rates, to which local jurisdictions add surcharges to distribute water to their customers. Toledo does not control what other jurisdictions add to their contract rates; outside communities have added surcharges of 30% to more than 250%. Local jurisdictions can provide specific rate information for their residents.

DPU also provides sewage treatment for areas outside the City of Toledo. **Toledo sewer charges are comprised of a fixed rate based on meter size plus a volume charge based on water usage.**

CCF = 100 Cubic Feet = 748 gallons

Residential/Commercial.....\$3.009 per CCF

Industrial.....\$3.391 per CCF
